MEDICATIONS THAT MUST BE STOPPED 7 DAYS PRIOR TO SURGERY

Aspirin and anti-inflammatory medications slow down your body's ability to form blood clots. This increases the chance of bleeding. Having a procedure and taking certain medicines place you at risk for bleeding. Therefore, you must stop taking any products that contain these drugs beforehand.

Many over-the-counter and prescription medications contain aspirin or NSAIDs. Below is a list of common medications that contain these drugs. While this list contains the most common products, it is not all-inclusive. Please check with your pharmacist or Primary Care Doctor if you have any questions.

The following list of medications MUST be stopped 7 days before surgery:
