2019 was a special year for our organization. While much of our industry is struggling to keep up with the demands of savvy patients and an ever-changing healthcare landscape, TCO is thriving and leading the charge toward a better future.

This year, we had the privilege of treating more patients than ever before. **101,913** people trusted us with their care for the first time, and **99%** said they would recommend TCO to family and friends. An incredible **1,588** of you took the time to tell us about your experience or leave a review online, and we are deeply humbled to be part of such a powerful community.

TCO is recognized as a global leader, as evidenced by patients coming from **50** states and **8** countries to receive care. Our value-based care model is a blueprint for others to follow, led by our EXCEL Surgery & Recovery program, which celebrated its milestone **5,000**th patient. Orthopedic Urgent Care locations proudly provide the metro with access to muscle, bone, and joint specialists 12 hours a day, 365 days a year. And our experts spent the year improving medicine through research studies, published literature, and presentations to world experts.

Training HAUS, our cutting-edge sports performance philosophy, continued to expand beyond its flagship Eagan – Viking Lakes location to reach more athletes than ever before. We are now developing the next generation of champions in locations across the metro, including our newest innovation, TCO Waconia Therapy & Sports Performance.

Supporting the local communities where we live and work is incredibly important to us, which is why we supported over **961** local events, teams, and organizations this year. TCO and Training HAUS also formed new official sports medicine and sports performance partnerships with **29** local high schools and universities.

VALUE-BASED CARE

In order to deliver value-based care, you first need to define "value." We define value with a simple equation: Value = Outcomes + Experience ÷ Cost

If a patient reports better **OUTCOMES**, such as reduced pain after surgery, or faster recovery, then value increases. Similarly, if a patient has an outstanding care EXPERIENCE that exceeds their expectations, value increases. If a procedure is more efficient and results in a lower COST to the insurance company or patient, value increases.

Many healthcare organizations struggle to define and measure the components that make up value, which is understandable. It's not easy. But TCO spent years developing the systems and processes necessary to deliver true, measurable, value-based care. And it's working.



OUTCOMES

TCO measures outcomes by gathering patient-reported feedback following surgical procedures. Thanks to our patients who report their progress at key milestones along their journeys, we're able to set realistic expectations for future patients, and find opportunities to improve our procedures.

EXPERIENCE

We measure experience by gathering patientreported feedback following all clinical visits and procedures. Thanks to our patients who report on their willingness to recommend TCO to family and friends, we're able to identify more ways to exceed expectations.

COST

Cost is not solely defined as the amount of money a patient pays for a procedure. Rather, it reflects the total cost of care. Depending on individual insurance plans, a patient may only pay a small percentage of the total cost of care. So why should they care about the total cost, if their out-of-pocket may not be affected? Because ultimately, patients pay the price for bloated expenses resulting in higher premiums and limited networks.


