

What to Expect After an Injection

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- 1. It can take 2 4 weeks for the injection to take effect.
- 2. You may experience an increase in pain after the injection.
- 3. Possible post-injection symptoms:
 - a. Facial flushing
 - b. Changes in blood pressure
 - c. Inability to sleep at night
 - d. Heart palpitations/irregularity
 - e. Change in blood sugars
- 4. The injections may not always give you relief.
 - a. You may need to discuss next steps with your doctor if the injections don't provide relief.
- 5. As arthritis progresses, the effectiveness of the injections may decrease.
- 6. With Hyaluronic Acid (HA) injections, the 2nd and 3rd injections may be more uncomfortable that the 1st injection.
- 7. Cortisone injections may be repeated every 4 months and HA injections may be repeated every 6 months.
